- Department name: Clay County Health Department
- Overview of the program: Clay County Public Health Center offers a wide range of clinic services. Some services are available to everyone, some to Clay County residents only, and others are for residents who are uninsured, underinsured, or on Medicaid. Some services are age restricted.
- Overview of the internship: Working with the WIC and Case Management Program Managers the Intern will research and implement evidence based interventions for Women's Health and Case Management. The Intern will research and develop curriculum for a Breastfeeding Basics Class. The Intern may be involved with multiple other projects throughout the Division and Agency as required.
  - When are these positions offered?
    - Start date May 23, 2016
    - End date July 27, 2016
  - Hours required (internships are typically 360 hours total) 9 weeks @ 40 hours per week + two additional 8-hour days
  - Location: Mostly on-site with occasional meetings/events off-site
  - Pay/ Stipend: not applicable
  - Travel: Local travel may be required/reimbursement TBD
  - Transportation – is a car required: Vehicle is required
  - Housing – if outside of Columbia MO, is housing available: Housing is not available
