- **Internship position title:** Population Health Nursing Consultant
- **Number of Interns needed:** 1
- **Website and/or overview of the program:** Missouri Center for Nursing Excellence and Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (DHSS) Public Health Nursing (PHN) Coordinator are collaborating to equip nurses in Missouri with critical population health skills to ensure nurses in Missouri are leading the way to better health where they work and live.

The population health nursing workgroup has already completed the initial phase of the Culture of Health Initiative (CHIP) project by surveying nurse employers regarding population health nursing skills.

Next steps include conducting a survey of nurses in Missouri (January-March 2018) then writing up the findings and recommendations for publication and grant application.

 - Validate survey tool for population health nursing
 - Analyze results of survey data
 - Work with the DHSS PHN Coordinator and Missouri Center for Nursing committee to develop a paper and grant proposal with results and recommendations for population health nursing resources and education offerings needed.
